This warden message is being issued to notify U.S. citizens traveling to and residing in Tarija that a consular official will be visiting Tarija on April 9, 2010. The official will be conducting an open town hall meeting from 2:00 to 3:00 p.m. at the Hotel Los Parrales conference room. Following the town hall meeting, the consular official will be available from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. to accept passport and birth certificate applications and register individuals to vote.

For passport and birth certificate applications, please consult the American Citizens Service section of the Embassy website at <http://bolivia.usembassy.gov/acs.html> for more information. Also, please take both the original and a photocopy of all supporting and identification documentation to present to the consular official.
